### Care leave

- Up to 9 months' income support
- Serious, treatable illnesses
- Carer must take on all care tasks
- Used for several chronic conditions

### Palliative leave

- No time limit on income support
- Terminal illness, treatment ceased
- No defined tasks for the family
- Almost exclusively used for cancer
- Separate legislation for children under 18
- Can be shared among several family members



NB: free choice requires a realistic alternative

NB: income support limits may lead to social inequality
